Scale of Pay & Grade Pay:

- **Driver:** Rs. 14,000 – Rs.60,500/- + G.P. Rs.5, 200/- PM
- **Peon/ Chowkidar:** Rs. 12,000/- Rs.52,000/- + G.P. Rs. 3,900/- PM

Minimum Education Qualification:

- **Driver:** Applicant must read upto Class-X and must have a valid 4(FOUR) wheeler driving license (LMV) issued by District Transport Officer, Govt of Assam and must have recent Government Doctor certified vision certificate.
- **Peon / Chowkidar:** Class-VIII passed.

Age: Candidate should not be less than 18 (Eighteen) years of age and not more than 38 years of age as on 1st January,2021. The relaxation of upper age limit shall be applicable as per Rules to OBC/MOBC, SC, ST(P)& ST(H).

Fees: No application fees required as per Govt. Notification NO. FEG.32/2016/12 dated. 21st May,2018.

Terms & Conditions:

1. Interested candidates shall have to fill up the **ONLINE application Form** available in the official website **labourcommissionerassam.gov.in**. **Applicant can apply for 1 (one) post only.**
2. Documents to be uploaded:
 - i. One recent Passport size photograph.
 - ii. Signature of the applicant.
 - iii. Date of Birth proof (school certificate, admit card, birth certificate issued by the competent authority)
 - iv. Permanent Residency Certificate/Domicile certificate
 - v. Caste Certificate. (if applicable)
 - vi. Class VIII certificate for peon / chowkidar
 - vii Class-X certificate for driver
 - viii. Valid driving license issued by the appropriate authority, Govt of Assam for driver
 - ix. Recent Government Doctor certified vision certificate for driver.
 - x. Valid employment registration card issued by District Employment Officer.
 - xi. EWS certificate issued by the appropriate authority for EWS candidates.

Mode of selection:

All candidates whose applications are accepted irrespective of post they applied for, shall appear for objective type written examination. Date and venue of examination centre will be intimated in their admit card. The syllabus for the written test will be published at a later date in the same website.

Final selection for the post of Peon and Chowkidar will be on the basis of merit list at the ratio of 1:4.

For the post of driver, shortlisted candidates based on merit at the ratio of 1:4 will be called to appear for driving test. Final selection for the post of driver will be based on marks obtained in written test and driving skill test.

There will be no viva-voce for all categories.

How to apply:

1. Applicants are required to apply online only within last date. No application will be accepted/entertained after the expiry of the given time. No offline application will be accepted.

2. Before applying candidates are advised to carefully go through the instructions provided in the website.

Issue of Admit Card:

1. Admit card will be issued electronically.
2. Date for download of Admit card will be published at a later date in the website.

* **Note:** Date, Time and Venue of examination shall be notified in the given official website in due course of time.

Canvassing directly or indirectly shall disqualify a candidate.

No TA/DA is admissible for appearing in the Written Test and Driving skill test.
